<b>Page Header</b>	Running head and page number	Student and professional versions. Student version doesn't require a running head.
<b>Section Labels</b>	Centered	Centered and bold (Paper title, References: all bold).
<b>Title Page</b>	Elements included: title of paper, author name(s), and institutional affiliation.	Additional elements included: paper title; author name(s), school/department, college/university name, course number and name, instructor name, and assignment due date.
<b>In-Text Citations: Multiple Authors</b>	Use of "et al." varied depending on number of authors.	All works with 3 or more authors are shortened to the last name of the first author plus "et al."
<b>Book References</b>	Publisher location required.	Publisher location <i>omitted</i> .
<b>DOIs</b>	Format for DOIs: doi:XXXXX	Format DOIs as hyperlinks: <a href="https://doi.org/xxxxx">https://doi.org/xxxxx</a>
<b>Hyperlinks</b>	Words "Retrieved from" preceded hyperlinks. Plain text links.	"Retrieved from" not required. Live links or plain text.
