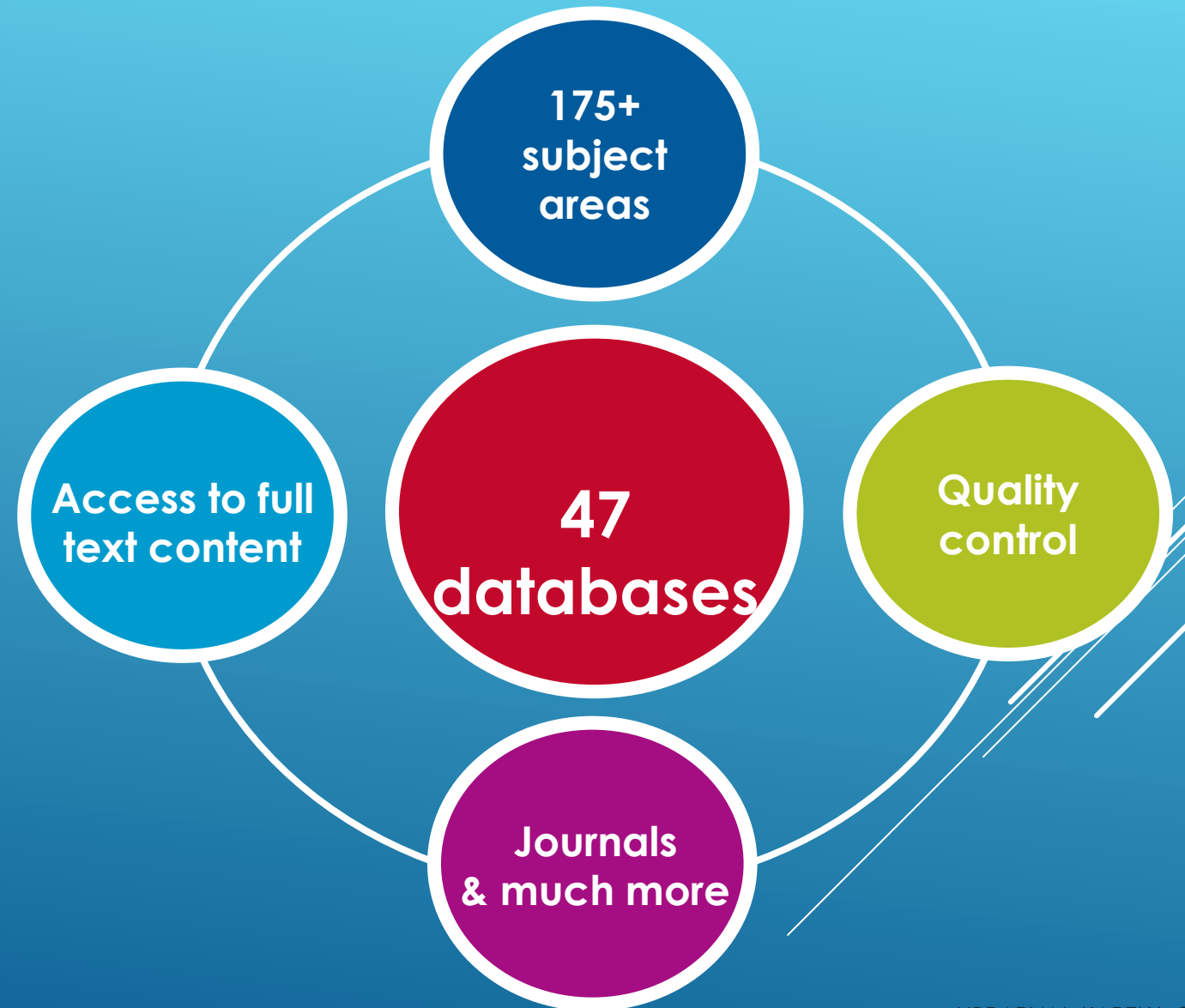
# WHAT IS PROQUEST CENTRAL?
