It includes levels ranging from Elementary School to University and Graduate school, as well as additional Degrees.

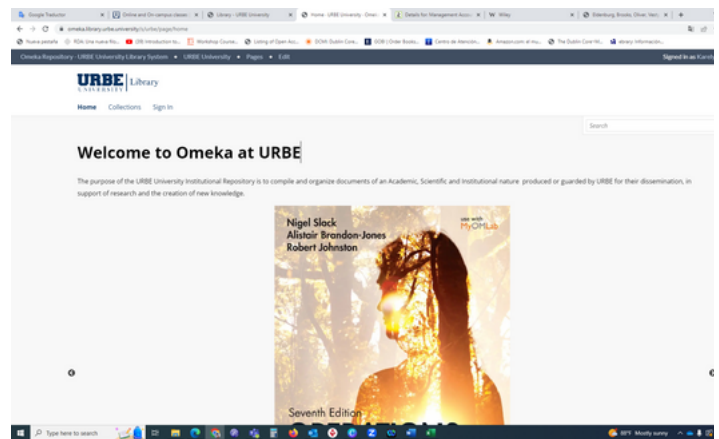

6 Modern Teaching Methods for Student Success.

July 6, 2023.

Teaching methods have evolved significantly over the years. In history remained the memorization of concepts to the letter and passive learning. A more interactive approach is now employed where the student actively participates in their learning through activities, debates, collaborative projects, and the encouragement of critical thinking. Pedagogically, activities have been designed to engage students' minds fully and ensure that they better understand the issues.

With advances in digital technologies and a global pandemic that forced educators to find new and alternative ways to meet the educational needs of their students, the educational landscape has changed and we can now see new teaching methods:

1- Kinesthetic Learning

Also known as tactile learning, kinesthetic learning is a hands-on style of teaching that encourages students to use their sense of touch by physically interacting with their subject.

Instead of lengthy explanations or descriptions in a book, students can get a real sense of how something works by building, testing, and witnessing it for themselves.

This hands-on approach to teaching goes beyond pure theory and is best suited to subjects that require physical manipulation, dexterity, and experiential learning, such as science, geography, art, music, and others.

2- Inquiry-Based Learning

This teaching method is far from the traditional styles of simply imparting knowledge to students and instead encourages them to ask questions and investigate to find the answers of their own free will. It engages your faculties of critical thinking and problem-solving through the use of open-ended questions, thereby arousing the student's natural curiosity and fostering an independent spirit to support their understanding and draw conclusions.

3- Differentiated Instruction

This teaching method focuses on the individual needs of the student and tailors instruction based on their interests, abilities, and learning styles.

Unlike a one-size-fits-all approach to teaching, differentiated instruction recognizes each individual's unique strengths and areas of growth, as well as their pace of learning to create an individualized education plan to maximize their overall learning experience.

4- Game-based learning

Game-based learning, or gamification, is a modern teaching technique that recognizes the power games have in the lives of children and young people and harnesses their ability to engage and inspire students in the learning process.

By incorporating game-based features such as characters, leaderboards, challenges, and rewards into educational content, teachers can encourage student engagement and enthusiasm for learning, while also fostering important twenty-first-century skills such as digital literacy and confidence in navigating new technologies.

5- Collaborative Learning

Through collaborative learning, students work together in small groups toward a shared goal. By encouraging cooperation, communication, and teamwork, this style of teaching allows students to interact with each other, share ideas, solve problems, and complete projects collaboratively, making learning easier.

It improves skills such as communication, teamwork and critical thinking, in addition to other valuable skills, such as relationship building, active listening, respect for diverse opinions and perspectives, conflict resolution, and adaptability.

6- Experiential Learning

Experiential learning is a teaching style that emphasizes hands-on experiences to facilitate learning and understanding in students.

By actively engaging in real-world experiences, students are less likely to become bored or distracted and are no longer just passive recipients of information, as their subject becomes practical rather than simply theoretical.

Examples of experiential learning include field trips, simulations, role-play activities, internships, community service, and hands-on experiments.

By bridging the gap between theory and practice, collaborative learning equips students with subject-specific knowledge and practical skills needed for success in their future projects.
