

International Newsstream

International Newsstream provides the most recent news content outside of the US and Canada, with archives which stretch back decades featuring newspapers, newswires, and news sites in active full-text format

U.S. Newsstream

U.S. Newsstream enables users to search the most recent premium U.S. news content, as well as archives which stretch back into the 1980s featuring top newspapers, newswires, blogs, and news sites in active full-text format

Academic Journals

Multi-Subject Database: Academic Journals is a broad-based publisher of peer-reviewed Open Access Journals. Academic Journals currently publishes 111 open access journals covering Art and Humanities, Business, Engineering, Medical Science, Social Sciences, Biological Sciences, Physical Sciences, etc.

Directory of Open Access Books

Multi-Subject; Provides access to e-books on various subjects.

Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)

Multi-Subject; DOAJ is an online directory that indexes and provides access to high quality, open access, peer-reviewed journals.

Elsevier Science Open Access Journals

All articles in open access journals which are published by Elsevier have undergone peer review and upon acceptance are immediately and permanently free for everyone to read and download.

Google Public Data Explorer

Data sets; Google's Public Data Explorer provides public data and forecasts from a range of international organizations and academic institutions including the World Bank, OECD, Eurostat and the University of Denver. These can be displayed as line graphs, bar graphs, cross sectional plots or on maps.

InTech Books

STEM e-books; Hundreds of free Open Access Books in the fields of Science, Technology and Medicine containing thousands of research articles and academic papers.

InTech Journals

Redalyc

8 Time Management Techniques For Busy People

CHRISTMAS DECEMBER 25, 2022
