
URBE University Library Webpage has a new section: **REMOTE LIBRARY INSTRUCTION**.

On the right side of all pages, notice:


- You can easily get back to the <u>home page</u> with its major sections.



CREATIVE COMMONS LICENCES


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There are six different <u>Creative Commons licenses</u>: CC BY, CC BY-SA, CC BY-NC, CC BY-ND, CC BY-NC-SA, CC BY-NC-ND. The letter pairs indicate conditions for use.

CC BY is the most open license. It allows the user to redistribute, to create derivatives, such as a translation, and even use the publication for commercial activities, provided that appropriate credit is given to the author (BY) and that the user indicates whether the publication has been changed.

CC BY-SA is also an open license. The letters SA (share alike) indicate that the adjusted work should be shared under the same reuse rights, so with the same CC license. NC (non-commercial use) and ND (no derivative works) are conditions that make the CC licenses more restrictive and thus less open.

The figure below shows a good overview of what each license permits you to do.

Strategies for Effective Reading

Reading is essential to study, especially when we are in college. We cannot read with a passive attitude, but with an active character to stimulate the development of learning.

If we are going to read to learn, we must do it consciously to understand, relate, memorize and apply knowledge. Read on to learn how to develop reading skills, what your goals are? and how to follow a proper strategy.

How to develop reading

Over time, reading skills develop and the process becomes more challenging. Complexity increases significantly from school books to scientific texts, so it is necessary to adapt to perspectives.

We start with a superficial approach aimed at collecting data and move on to a deep approach, where interpretation plays an essential role in getting the most out of the texts.

Reading then consists of a way of knowing what is said, in addition to recognizing and interpreting what is said considering the author's point of view.

Reading Objective

Everyone reads in their daily routine for different purposes, whether for entertainment, to study or to learn how to do something. Among the common goals of reading are:

 Obtain information of practical use, such as school schedules or movie listings. It does not require analysis or interpretation.

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- ♦ Entertain ourselves by reading fiction literature. Some interpretation can be applied to understand the author.
- Inform us with newspapers and magazines about news and current events. Interpretation is required to avoid falling into common biases.
- Prepare academically with books and magazines. These require a high level of interpretation and analysis with critical reading to identify what may be true.

In the case of academic readings, learning and thought development are pursued, incorporating new ideas, seeing things from different angles, promoting knowledge and understanding.

Learning, therefore, occurs not by reading and remembering details, but by developing an understanding of the meaning of details.

Necessary Reading Materials

Reading materials in college or university are divided into different types, for example:

- Course materials: depend on the institution, the discipline and the professor. They can be books, presentations, essays, magazine articles and others.
- Core Texts: These are essential readings that seek to expand on the themes, discussions, and arguments presented in the course materials. An understanding of these theories and ideas will need to be demonstrated.
- Suggested readings: allow to increase the understanding of a subject area, to greatly improve knowledge.
- Other sources: these are additional readings that complement the information that has been received by other sources.

Attitudes towards reading

When we start reading books related to a new topic, we find the language and style difficult to follow. Although it may be unpleasant or discouraging, we must persevere.

Gradually we will be able to become familiar with the writing style and vocabulary associated with the specific subject area. It is important to stay clear and be objective about what you are reading in order to see and understand the logic within an argument.

Subjectivity means bringing your own emotions and opinions to what you read; instead, being objective allows you to be emotionally detached from your reading to focus on the content and not the feelings about what you read.

Through reading we can significantly improve our personal and professional skills

The World Autism Awareness Day is celebrated each year on **April 2** globally. It is celebrated with the goal of spreading awareness about Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). ASD is a developmental disorder which leads to the impairment of communication and social interaction skills in an individual.

Background of Autism Awareness Day

The holiday was proposed to the United Nations by the Qatar representative Her Highness Sheikha Mozah Bint Nasser Al-Missned, on November 1st, 2007, and adopted on December 18 of the same year. Thus, April 2nd was established as the day for the holiday, and the first observance happened in 2008.

The proposal had the support of all the member states but did not go to a vote, as it was considered by the UN to be a matter of human rights. This one of seven health-related holidays observed by the United Nations, on this day, the UN invites all its member states and private health organizations to take part in raising awareness with the public about autism.

Autism is a developmental disability that affects and impairs a person's brain functions. autistic people have trouble with social interactions and communicating with others, as well as struggling with getting engaged in some activities. There are several degrees of autism, but it is a disorder that can impact anyone regardless of gender or country.

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Good Friday for the year 2022 is celebrated/observed on

Friday, April 15th.

Good Friday is a Christian observance held two days before Easter Sunday and it commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus Christ at Calvary (located right outside the walls of Jerusalem). Good Friday is the sixth day of Holy week and is also known as Holy Friday, Great Friday, Black Friday and Easter Friday. The day is also part of the Paschal Triduum that starts on the evening of Maundy Thursday and continues to Easter Sunday recalling the passion, death, burial and resurrection of Christ.

Facts To Know About Good Friday

- No meat on Good Fridays: Catholics are not supposed to consume meat on Good Friday. They can have one complete meal or two smaller ones on this day.
- The Most Somber Day: Good Friday is considered the most somber day of the Christian Year, and it's suggested that the worship room should be stripped of any adornment.
- 3 pm is the time that Jesus is thought to have died, after being agonized on the cross for six hours, and this is the reason why Roman Catholics start their service at 3 pm. In many churches, it takes the form of a meditation based on seven sayings, or last words of Jesus on the cross; with hymns, prayers, and short sermons.




Every year on April 22, Earth Day marks the anniversary of the birth of the modern environmental movement in 1970.

World Book Day, also known as World Book and Copyright Day or International Day of the Book, is an annual event organized by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to promote reading, publishing, and copyright.

The first World Book Day was celebrated on 23 April in 1995, and continues to be recognized on that day. In 1995, UNESCO decided that the World Book and Copyright Day would be celebrated on 23 April, as the date is also the anniversary of the death of William Shakespeare and Inca Garcilaso de la Vega, as well as that of the birth or death of several other prominent authors. (In a historical coincidence, Shakespeare and Cervantes died on the same *date* — 23 April 1616 — but not on the same *day*, as at the time, Spain used the Gregorian calendar and England used the Julian calendar; Shakespeare actually died 10 days after Cervantes died, on 3 May of the Gregorian calendar.)




